- Deal effectively with challenging behaviour

Qualifications:

- Experience working in a day camp or other social or recreational setting as a program leader
- Strong knowledge of age appropriate games, sports, outings and arts and crafts for children
- Post secondary education in a related field
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
